Happy New Year!



The Medieval Observance of the new year varied much in different countries and time periods. For much of the period called the middle ages, March 25th was the first day of many Europeans' new year. This day is the Feast day of the Annunciation and the first day of spring. Not all countries restarted their calendars on this date, yet most communities had grand parades and celebrations. France, for example, had its New year on April 16th, in Venice it was March 1st, and in other areas, it was on Christmas or Easter.

Frances and Joseph Gies summed up this complicated system in their book, *Life in a Medieval City*, stating:

"...A traveller setting out from Venice on March 1, 1245, the first day of the Venetian year; finding himself in 1244 when he reached Florence; and after a short stay going on to Pisa, where he would enter the year 1246. Continuing westward, he would return to 1245 when he entered Provence, and upon arriving in France before Easter (April 16) he would be once more in 1244."

In 1581, Pope Gregory XIII changed the new years date to be officially January 1. Pope Gregory also switched from the inaccurate Julian Calendar to the Gregorian Calendar. He Changed the calendar on October 4, 1582. The next day became October 15th.

January 1st already had a church feast day which began during the thirteenth century AD. The feast is called the Feast of Fools. In two hundred years of festivities, this feast became a wild carnival affair. Although the catholic church had pulled the reins on parishioners' wild lewd behavior, for the secular populous, there were no controls. Celebrations became somewhat controlled by the late fifteen hundreds, but a feast day is a feast day and an opportunity to celebrate.

The Coptic Church uses another calendar based on the Egyptian civil calendar. It has three seasons with twelve months containing 30 days. At the end of these three seasons is a 5 day month. On leap years this month has 6 days. The New Year starts on Gregorian calendar date of September 11 for non-leap year years, and September 12 during a leap year.

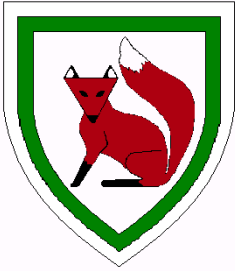

TWELFTH NIGHT TRADITIONS:

In 567 the Council of Tours proclaimed that the entire period between Christmas and Epiphany should be considered part of the celebration, creating what became known as the twelve days of Christmas, or what the English called Christmastide. On the last of the twelve days, called Twelfth Night, various cultures developed a wide range of additional special festivities. The variation extends even to the issue of how to count the days. If Christmas Day is the first of the twelve days, then Twelfth Night would be on January 5, the eve of Epiphany. If December 26, the day after Christmas, is the first day, then Twelfth Night falls on January 6, the evening of Epiphany itself.
